गणितातील भास्कराचार्यः एक अद्वितीय गणितज्ञ

दैनंदिन जीवनात गणित हा एक अत्यंत महत्त्वाचा विषय आहे, जो कधीही विचार करण्यासारखा आहे. म्हणूनच, गणिताला विज्ञानाची भाषा असे म्हटले जाते. गणित हा विषय अनेकांना गहन आणि समजून घेण्यासाठी आव्हानात्मक वाटतो. परंतु भारतीय गणिततज्ञांनी या विषयाला सर्वसामान्यांसाठी समजण्यास सुलभ बनवण्यासाठी खूप प्रयत्न केले आहेत. गणितातील प्रगतीमध्ये भारतीय गणिततज्ञांनी अमूल्य योगदान आहे. यांपैकी एक म्हणजे भास्कराचार्य. बाविसाव्या शतकात भारता मध्येच नव्हे, तर संपूर्ण जगात गणित आणि खगोलशास्त्रात योगदान देणारे भास्कराचार्य हे एक असामान्य व्यक्तिमत्त होते. भास्कराचार्यांचा जन्म १११४ साली, आंध्र प्रदेशातील चाळीस गावाजवळील पारण या गावात झाला. भास्कराचार्य उत्तम कवीही होते.

भास्कराचार्यांनी 'लीलावती' हा गणितावर लिहिलेला महत्त्वाचा ग्रंथ तयार केला. या ग्रंथाची सुलभ मांडणी, शिकवण्याची आकर्षक पद्धत, सोपी उदाहरणे, रसाळ भाषा यामुळे हा ग्रंथ अतिशय लोकप्रिय झाला. भास्कराचार्यांनी 'थिअरी ऑफ नंबर्स' या गणिताच्या शाखेत काम करून सांगितले की कोणत्याही संख्येला शून्याने भाग दिल्यास उत्तर अनिश्चित येते. भास्कराचार्यांनी गणितातील कॅलक्युलस या शाखेतही महत्त्वाची प्रगती केली आणि त्यांना लिमिट या संकल्पनेची माहिती होती. त्रिकोणमितीतही त्यांनी महत्त्वाचे कार्य केले. तसेच रोजच्या व्यवहारात लागणारे गणित समजण्यासाठी त्यांनी 'बीजगणित' हा ग्रंथ लिहिला, ज्यामध्ये आजही शालेय जीवनात शिकल्या जाणाऱ्या अनेक समीकरणांचा समावेश आहे.

भास्कराचार्य उत्तम ज्योतिषाचार्यही होते. त्यांनी ज्योतिषशास्त्राच्या संदर्भात 'सिद्धांतशिरोमणी' हा ग्रंथ लिहिला, ज्यामध्ये धन व ऋण संख्यांचे नियम, शून्याच्या संदर्भातील नियम, गणितीय नियम इत्यादीांचा समावेश आहे. 'गोलाध्याय' हा ज्योतिषशास्त्रावरचा अजून एक महत्त्वाचा ग्रंथही भास्कराचार्यांनी लिहिला. भास्कराचार्यांना अनंत ही संकल्पनाही माहिती होती, तसेच त्यांनी परिघ व व्यास यांचा उपयोगही केला.

शून्यापासून अनंतापर्यंत, घन संख्यांपासून ऋण संख्यांपर्यंत, बीजगणितामधील समीकरणांपासून कॅलक्युलमध्ये वापरल्या जाणाऱ्या कल्पनांपर्यंत, त्रिकोणिमतीपासून ते नंबर थिअरीपर्यंत, गणित आणि ज्योतिषशास्त्रातील अमूल्य कामगिरी करणाऱ्या या गणितज्ञाचे कार्य सर्व भारतीयांसाठी प्रेरणादायी आहे. गणिताला काव्याची उंची देणाऱ्या आणि काव्याला गणिताचे सौंदर्य देणाऱ्या या महान गणिततज्ञाला मी अभिवादन करते.







