

Gamma for extrasensory perception and Kappa for psychokinesis.

For those aspiring to obtain a degree in parapsychology, it is essential to pursue science in the 12th grade or opt for the arts stream. While one can study parapsychology abroad, in India, there are only three universities offering this discipline:

i) Andhra Pradesh University

ii) Delhi University

iii) Punjab University

Parapsychology opens a gateway to understanding the mysterious facets of human consciousness and the unexplored dimensions of the mind. As we continue to unravel the secrets of the paranormal, this field remains at the intersection of science and the supernatural, challenging our perceptions and expanding the horizons of human knowledge.

The celebration concluded with a dance featuring both grandparents and their grandchildren.


